



At least two Iraqi families of victims killed by Blackwater security guards in September tell ABC News they have refused compensation offered by the company.

Officials familiar with the case told ABCNews.com last month that Blackwater had **resisted U.S. government demands**

that the company pay at least \$100,000 per death, claiming the U.S. government itself hasn't paid that much in similar situations.
